Bowl-a-thon and Silent Auction

for 2022 World Down Syndrome Awareness Day

What: Bowl-a-thon and Silent Auction

Where: Chipper's Lanes at 217 W. Horsetooth Rd., Fort Collins

When: 5-7 p.m., Sunday, March 6, 2022

Why: To raise money for the International Mosaic Down Syndrome Association (imdsa) and give folks a chance to take part in a fun activity with people of all ages and ability levels.

- How:**
1. Put a team of six bowlers together of any age (last year we had ages 2-74). Each team member pays \$20 for two hours of bowling, shoes, ball and admission to a silent auction at Chipper's Lanes.
 2. Alternatively, give a donation sheet to each team member with your contact information on it. The team members then solicit tax deductible donations for imdsa, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization (EIN 42:1533098). If the team raises \$300 or more for imdsa (via silent auction donations or cash contributions), each bowler pays only \$15 for their entrance fee. Please note that bowlers from the same family will pay no more than \$75 total to participate for a family of five or fewer, or \$100 for a family of six to eight. Checks can be made out to imdsa.
 3. Please reassure everyone that all safety measures will be followed per country COVID-19 guidelines.
 4. Timeline: As team leader, please turn in the list of bowlers for your team and whether or not bumper pads or ramps are needed to Roxanne at sensaonline2@yahoo.com by March 1, 2021.
